Best Practice No. I

Title : Awareness Programs In Pandemic Situation

Objectives : To Motivate People to face adverse conditions and sensitization about social issues in the pandemic situation.

Context : In the intense circumstances of Pandemic situation. It was necessary to conduct awareness programmes in Shendurjanaghat and surrounding rural area because of the scarcity of treatment of COVID-19 and lack of hospitals. Therefore, the NSS unit of our college initiated and conducted a Pandemic awareness Programme in nearby villages, Satnur and Zatanxiri. In this programme, eminent doctors were invited to guide the people to avoid COVID-19 disease and insist on a hygienic life style. In the same programme, masks were distributed to the villages on a large scale without any cost. As a result, very few people found Corona positive, but a large number of people could save themselves from COVID-19. In this practice programme, office, NSS volunteers and all staff members of the college worked with devotion and dedication under the guidance of the Honorable principal.

Evidence of Success : On 31/03/2021, under the National Service Scheme of Dr. Shyamaprasad Mukherjee Arts College, Shendurjanaghat, a COVID-19 virus outbreak and self-awareness and mask distribution program was organized in Satnur and Zatanxiri village. On this occasion, awareness was created in people about the effects of COVID-19 infection and its remedies. The Deputy Sarpanch of Satnur village and the villagers supported this activity under the guidance of Hon'ble Principal Dr. R.N. Fulari sir. The Principal Sir informed the villagers about the measures taken against COVID-19 virus and its incidence. He discussed with the villagers about the importance of cleanliness in the village and gave information about various measures to be taken to control the disease COVID-19 and government cooperation and assistance.

Obstacles : 1) Approaching roads are very poor means, full of pits and stones, so it is difficult to visit frequently to nearby villages.
2) Doctors were not available when the doctors were in their villages for their daily farming works.
3) To collect the villagers together for an awareness programme is a difficult task.
4) Scarcity of funds for arranging such a program.

Title : College student responsibility Fund (CSR) Student Welfare activity

Objectives :


- 1) Provision of welfare fund to the economically weaker students.
- 2) Encourage economically backward student to appear for University examination so that no student could be deprived from University and competitive examinations.
- 3) Provision of medical help to poor students.

Context : Our college has started college student responsibility fund policy as per the direction of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. College has taken the sanction of this scheme in the second meeting of C.D.C. and try to help economically backward students so that they could not be deprived from the university and competitive examinations and medical help.

Evidence of Success : We had major problem of scarcity of funds to start this scheme. Therefore after long discussion it is decided in the meeting of constituted committee of C.S.R. that every staff member should contribute at least 200/- Rs. per month from their salary. Similarly contribution in the form of cash up to rupees 1,10,000 is taken from the various prestigious people and fulfill the task to help financially weaker students. In results the above mentioned activity is running successfully and help number of students for their examination fees purpose, medical purposes and also to provide the purpose of college dress to the students. We are happy to write here the program is running successfully and could help many of the students of college.

Obstacles :

- 1) It is difficult to select economically backward students.
- 2) People seem to be hesitated to contribute in the Scheme.
- 3) It is difficult to convince the people to help to a poor student.
- 4) Sometimes students do not respond to the Scheme.
- 5) The expectation of students are very high which cannot be fulfilled by the college.
